The monograph concerns the socio-economic area of the Murmansk region as well as specifics in its control and development prospects. The Murmansk regional character meets the general Russian and northern particularities revealed through the econometric modeling of public production in Russia and in a group of the Northern regions.

The author considers comprehensively the social infrastructure of the Murmansk region. The issues of socio-economic differentiation of regional towns and districts are of special importance. Particular attention is given to the administrative questions in the frame of providing tasks on the Russian Arctic zone development and supporting balanced socio-economic development of the Murmansk region as a separate administrative object.

The study was performed within the State Task of IES KSC RAS and R&D works supported by grants of scientific funds. The problems were observed which had been studied in research supported by grants of RFBR Department for Humanities and Government of the Murmansk region No.17-12-51003 (chapter 1), No.17-12-51002 (chapter 4), as well as grant RFH and Government of the Murmansk region No.15-12-51002 (§3.2).

The monograph is intended for wide community of specialists, including scientific researchers, professors of high and specialized secondary schools and is recommended for post-graduate students in specialties 08.00.01, 08.00.05, 08.00.13.
